Re: Proposed Extraction / Landfill Walkford Farm

Dear Mr Lamb,

Many thanks for your letter Dated 4th September 2006 Reference 'Core Strategy/PEM/ notice letter' which relates to above. Thanking you for the invitation to discuss the above in Winchester, I prefer to continue hard copy discussion on the above.

I enclose a copy of my letter to Secretary of State David Miliband. Dated 11th August 2006 Ref:W.P.1/D which clearly relates to '**Proposed Extraction / Landfill Walkford Farm**'.

You may see from reading the letter that our objections, mine and that of the Petitioners are based on three key elements as follows:

This proposed project is seriously flawed on the following counts:

- (1) That Gavel Extraction resulting in a Refuge Tip / Land Fill next to an established and ongoing Burial Ground as a direct result. This is both. '**Immoral and Unethical**'.
- (2) The fact that 'Walkford Brook' lies between two large areas of this proposed project. Water from this fast flowing brook travels through Chewton Glen, then Chewton Bunny and finally into the sea at Higcliffe Beach. This could possibly result in **deadly Toxins poisoning a large area**, especially the sea and beaches below at Highcliffe.
- (3) An '**Electrified Railway Line**' runs across the southern parameters of this proposed site in a deep gully. Thus any escaping '**Methane Gases**' could accumulate especially in cold weather and result in an **explosion** and derailment and possibly death.

I do hope you realise, that over two thousand burials have been carried out in the Hinton Park Woodland Burial site. This may well have serious ramifications as friends and relatives realise that loved ones are, if you continue your plans, going to be surrounded by one enormous Rubbish Tip?
